### DESCRIPTION

The North Queensferry railway station has been recently refurbished with careful attention to keeping its Victorian 1890 heritage. New modern facilities such as accessible toilets and free WiFi are included. The Station has secure glass windows throughout the building which provides lots of natural light.

- Trains run from Edinburgh nearly every 20 minutes on the Fife Circle route.
- Private car/Mini-Bus - KY11 1HE. - free Car parking for approximately 20 cars.

- Forth Bridge & Heritage wall displays

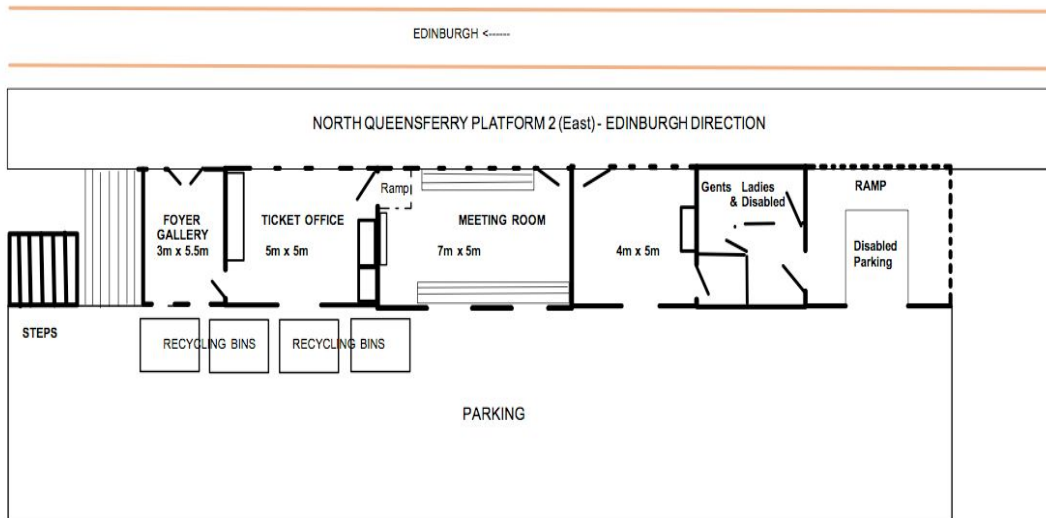
