Dear Member.

Your membership of the North Queensferry Heritage Trust is gratefully appreciated because it allows us to continue with our efforts in highlighting the rich heritage of North Queensferry. This is your annual notice for renewal of your membership.

The Trust has a few main responsibilities: the management of the Forth Bridge Heritage Centre at the Railway Station building and the Light Tower, both of which can be classified as visitor attractions; the annual Village Show; and from 2020, the possibility of adopting the BT Phone Box on Main Road.

The Station: the Trust's policy is to keep the Gallery open as much as possible acting as a waiting room as well as having an exhibition constantly on display. A fully accessible Public Toilet facility is also provided Note - the Trust has installed a **Defibrillator Unit** at the station that is registered with the Police and Scottish Ambulance Service and is available 24/7 on the Edinburgh-bound platform.

The Light Tower on the Town Pier continues to be open as often as possible, subject to weather and now attracts over 10,000 visitors per year. It has also just undergone a comprehensive refurbishment and is now ready for visitors and "light the lamp" reservations. Also, watch out this year for a VIP Light the Lamp package!

BT Phone Box on the Main Street is up for adoption. The Heritage Trust has applied and is waiting to hear if our application has been successful. We believe it will make an excellent Information Kiosk for visitors to learn about the heritage and history of our beautiful and ancient village.

Website: The website at www.nqht.org includes the previous light tower website. It also includes information on: searching the village census from 1841 to 1911; the War Memorial and the stories associated with the listed names; the 'Destination Forth-WW1' exhibition - is now even more fully documented on the website under the label 1918. The website incorporates an easy to read layout with a great deal of other 'heritage', including 'natural heritage' from our very own John Done. The latest major addition has been the Golf Course from 1890, and makes a fascinating read.
